

Rewild Bushcraft Activity Days:

Our bushcraft activity days are half or full day sessions where students come to learn how to 'survive in the wild'. All of our days can be tailored to suit the specific aims and requirements of your students.



Overview:

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| Who is this programme for? | Our bushcraft days are most suited to groups of between 20-30 students from KS2 and KS3. However, this is only guidance, and we can alter the day to suit the students in the group. |
| What type of activities does the day include? | <p>Dependant on the specific requirements of your students, we can offer a range of activities. The most popular of these are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Orienteering - Shelter building - Fire making (and fire safety) - Trap building - Problem solving tasks/puzzles - Team building activities |
| What skills will be developed during the day? | As well as the hard skills that are taught, such as shelter building, students will also be encouraged develop lots of soft skills, such as leadership skills, working with others, communication, creativity, resourcefulness and many more. |
| What is the cost? | The costs vary depending on the time of activities you would like – please contact us directly for more information. |

Example of a bushcraft day:

A usual bushcraft day starts with arrival to our site for around 9:00am, where we will meet around the fire to introduce the day and go through key safety information. From here, students will spend the morning in teams doing problem solving tasks and orienteering to get used to the forest. So, however, the students will discover that they have become 'stranded' in the wilderness and will have to develop skills to survive. Over lunch around the fire, we will discuss what they think the most important skills for survival are, before we break into groups to spend the afternoon building shelters and traps. At around 2:00pm, students will come back together to finish the day talking about the importance of protecting our natural world and celebrate with some popcorn made over the open fire. The day usually ends around 2:30, after a short 'graduation' and certificate ceremony.
